CHAPTER III

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

This chapter presents the procedure of the entire research process. It consists of four sections: research method, data collection, data analysis, data KAN presentation, and synopsis of the novel.

3.1 Research Method

The methodology applied in this study is a qualitative approach and is delivered descriptively. It means that the data which is being analyzed will be delivered in the form of description.

Qualitative approach aims to understand the richness and complexity of social experience by attending closely to the actions, interactions, and social contexts of everyday life. According to Kirk and Miller (1986) qualitative approach research and study the human behavior and interaction in their territory or speaking with them in depth about their thoughts and feelings.

A descriptive approach was used as the framework for the research. This includes collecting and analyzing the data. The textual evidence which concern on the main character's changing gender issue were taken as the data.

3.2 Data Collection and Analysis

The study researches a novel entitled *Middlesex* written by Jeffrey Euginides which becomes the source data of the research. The novel was published by Bloomsbury publishing in 2003. It consists of four sections, 28 chapters and 529 pages.

From the study, the data will be collected by enlightening the main character's changing gender factors. After identifying the text, the data is listed and then it is classified into some categorizations.

After the data was collected, it will be classified into some categorizations. The data is classified into 3 sections: the changing gender factors, the taking and resisting the new gender identity of the main character. After that, the next steps is analyzing the data using the gender theory. The last one is writing the interpretations, giving elaboration, and presenting conclusion.

3.3 Data Presentation

The data which has been collected are presented in the next chapter with the discussion. The data is categorized into three sections: the changing gender factors, the taking, and the resisting new gender identity. Those data will comprise the secondary sexual characteristics development, self-acceptance, sexual orientation, physical appearance, family and social relation of the main character.

3.4 Synopsis of the Novel *Middlesex*

It is a story about hermaphrodite named Calliope. At first, Calliope was born as a baby girl, but then Calliope figured out that she genetically is a male. Calliope grew up as a normal girl before she knew that she genetically is a male.

Calliope was born on January 1960 in Detroit. Her parents are Milton and Tessie; both of them come from Greek-American descendants. Milton's parents are Greek who immigrated to United States because of the war. Lefty Stephanides and Desdemona were bother and sister. Lefty was Desdemona's younger brother.
