

CHAPTER 5

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter is the last chapter of this study. It presents the conclusions and suggestions of the research. The conclusions are made based on the result of the findings and discussions in chapter four. Meanwhile, the suggestions are specified for further research in order to fulfill the needs of language study.

5.1 Conclusions

In analyzing English word formation processes in teenager magazine, especially “HighEnd Teen” Magazine in June 2008 Edition, the writer concludes that so many creativity from young people that appear in the language which is used in the magazine. It is shown by the appearance of acronym, blending, and clipping which are some of English word formation processes that found in “HighEnd Teen” Magazine in June 2008 edition. Teenager magazine tries to use the shorter words through those processes in making the simple language that could be mentioned easily and shortly.

Other English word formations that also appear in this study are compounding and derivation. English derivational affixes found in this study are shown by the appearance of prefix and suffix. Suffix is the most frequently appear in the magazine,

while blending is the process that most infrequently appear than other five English word formation processes found.

Blending could be the most infrequently used in the magazine, the writer argues that it is happened because blending process rarely occurred in our daily communication. It seems that blend words are rarely used and created. In the contrary, suffix could be the most frequently appear in the magazine because it is often appears in our daily communication, especially around Indonesian teenager (based on prior observation). The words added by suffix are often used and created. That is why almost in our daily communication, words added by suffix could be found easily.

5.2 Suggestions

For further research, there are some suggestions that can be considered. For the first suggestion, it will be interesting if the next research takes different media of communication in analyzing word formation processes. Besides magazine, there are a lot of media of communication that can be explored. There are so many social networks that can be analyzed, such as *twitter*, *facebook*, *friendster*, etc. It is really interesting to found out the language change that occurred in that social network. It is because so many new words appear through the discussion or communication in those circles. Besides social networks, there are so many other media of communication that also can be explored, such as movie, novel, utterances in radio,

newspaper, and many other media. Those media which is already mentioned are also interesting to be explored.

The second suggestion, it will be more challenging if the next researcher trying to found out new words created of the situation right now which is known as technology era. As we know, so many new things appear in our today's life and it causes so many new languages and words found. It is one of interesting idea to be discovered for the next research.

For of all, this study can be one of source for other research that deals with phenomena of word formation processes. It is also expected that this study would be valuable for those who are studying morphology or linguistic.
