
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

ABSTRACT

Podcast considered to be a media that can be deployed as listening material in English learning classrooms to improve the student's listening comprehension. Considering that podcast can be used as listening material that can improve listening comprehension, this study was conducted to explore the impact of podcast as listening material in improving Indonesian EFL students' listening comprehension and the student's perspective toward podcast as listening material in English learning classrooms. The study was conducted using one group pre-test and post-test research design with 34 tenth-grade students who became the participants of the study. The participants of the study received a treatment where they listened to podcast as the material for listening in the English learning classroom. Additionally, the students were required to answer a questionnaire that consisted of their perception of podcast as listening material after they had taken the post-test. The result of the study shows that there is an improvement in the participants' post-test results compared to the score that they obtained during the pre-test. The data from the questionnaire shows that the students responded positively towards podcast as listening material in English learning classrooms.

ABSTRAK

Podcast dianggap sebagai sebuah media yang dapat digunakan sebagai bahan ajar *listening* dalam kelas pembelajaran Bahasa Inggris untuk meningkatkan daya paham *listening* siswa. Dengan mempertimbangkan bahwa podcast dapat digunakan sebagai bahan ajar *listening* yang dapat meningkatkan daya paham *listening* siswa, Penelitian ini dilaksanakan untuk menyelidiki pengaruh dari penggunaan podcast sebagai bahan ajar *listening* dalam meningkatkan daya paham *listening* siswa EFL di Indonesia dan persepsi siswa terhadap podcast sebagai listening material di kelas Bahasa Inggris. Penelitian ini dilaksanakan menggunakan desain penelitian *one group pre-test and post-test* dengan 34 siswa kelas sepuluh menjadi partisipan dari penelitian ini. Para partisipan dari penelitian ini menerima sebuah perlakuan dimana mereka akan mendengarkan podcast sebagai bahan ajar untuk pembelajaran *listening* di kelas Bahasa Inggris. Selain itu, siswa diminta untuk menjawab angket yang berisi tentang persepsi mereka terhadap podcast sebagai materi *listening* setelah mereka menyelesaikan *post-test*. Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa ada peningkatan dari hasil *post-test* siswa jika dibandingkan dengan skor yang mereka dapatkan pada saat *pre-test*. Data dari angket menunjukkan bahwa para siswa menunjukkan respon positif terhadap podcast sebagai materi *listening* di kelas Bahasa Inggris.
