CONCLUSION

The use of the focalization concept in the children's book *Emmeline and The Plucky Pup* (2018) has revealed another portrayal of a feminist figure, Emmeline Pankhurst, as a child-friendly woman. In this book, besides being portrayed as the suffragette leader who often uses controversial militant tactics during the protests, Mrs. Pankhurst is also portrayed as a woman with a motherly side, which is reflected in her concern for the wellbeing of the child characters. By portraying Mrs. Pankhurst as a child-friendly woman, her character becomes more relatable and understandable for young readers. In addition, presenting a brave, determined, and generous woman in the story can also inspire young readers to value courage, perseverance, social justice and equality. In conclusion, the use of zero focalization and external focalization has simplified the portrayal of Mrs. Pankhurst into just two portrayals. Considering its implied reader, the book intends to introduce a complex feminist figure in a friendly and relatable manner as well as to disseminate an ideology in a subtle way.
