Penelitian ini dilatarbelakangi fenomena kesulitan membuat keputusan karier peserta didik SMK. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah (1) mengetahui gambaran kesulitan membuat keputusan karier peserta didik kelas XI SMK Angkasa Lanud Husein Sastranegara tahun ajaran 2014/2015, dan (2) mengembangkan program bimbingan dan konseling berdasarkan gambaran kesulitan membuat keputusan karier peserta didik SMK. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kuantitatif dan metode deskriptif. Sedangkan sampel penelitian menggunakan *Sample Random Sampling*. Pengolahan data menggunakan *SPSS 16.0 for Windows*. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan secara umum kesulitan membuat keputusan karier peserta didik berada pada kategori sedang.
