

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini dilatarbelakangi oleh perpustakaan yang harus memenuhi kebutuhan informasi pemustakanya. Perpustakaan harus dapat membuat kebijakan pengadaan koleksi yang baik sehingga dapat memberikan kebutuhan informasi yang sesuai dengan kebutuhan informasi pemustakanya. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk melihat kontribusi kebijakan pengadaan koleksi sirkulasi terhadap peningkatan frekuensi peminjaman bahan pustaka di SMAN 3 Cimahi. Penelitian ini menjawab permasalahan penelitian yang telah dirumuskan, yaitu “Bagaimana kontribusi kebijakan pengadaan koleksi sirkulasi terhadap peningkatan frekuensi peminjaman bahan pustaka di perpustakaan?”. Secara khusus permasalahan dalam penelitian ini yaitu: (1) kontribusi kebijakan pengadaan koleksi; (2) Kontribusi pengadaan koleksi sirkulasi; (3) Kontribusi cara peminjaman koleksi terhadap peningkatan frekuensi peminjaman bahan pustaka di SMAN 3 Cimahi. Penelitian ini dilakukan di Perpustakaan SMAN 3 Cimahi yang berlokasi di Jalan Pesantren No. 161 Telp. (022) 6652807 Kota Cimahi. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif, *expost-facto* pendekatan kuantitatif. Populasi dan sampel dari penelitian ini adalah pemustaka Perpustakaan SMAN 3 Cimahi. Sampel yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini sebanyak 90 orang, dengan menggunakan teknik *stratified random sampling*. Korelasi dari kontribusi kebijakan pengadaan koleksi sirkulasi terhadap peningkatan frekuensi peminjaman bahan pustaka di SMAN 3 Cimahi yang memiliki tingkat korelasi yang sangat kuat.

Circulation Collection Contribution Procurement Policy Borrower Against Increased Frequency Library Collection in Senior High School Library (ex-post facto research in Library of Senior High School 3 Cimahi)

This paper comes out of concerns that libraries must meet some requirements which its visitors need to get more information. Libraries should be able to create good collection procurement policies in order to provide information in accordance with the visitors' need. This study was aimed to investigate the influence of procurement collection circulation policy towards the increase of borrowed-book frequency in SMA Negeri 3 Cimahi. This research answered the formulated research question which is stated as follows: "How does the influence of the procurement collection circulation policy toward the improvement of borrower frequency in library?". Particularly, the problems of this research are: (1) the contribution of procurement collection policies; (2) the contribution of procurement collection; (3) The contribution of loaning way towards the increasing frequency of library's collection in SMAN 3 Cimahi. This research was conducted in the library of SMA Negeri 3 Cimahi which is located on Pesantren Street No. 161 Telp (022) 6652807 Cimahi. The research method of this research is descriptive method with ex-post-facto approach quantitatively. The population and sample of this study were the visitors of the library in SMAN 3 Cimahi. The sample used in this study were 90 respondent chosen by stratified random sampling technique. The correlation value of the contribution of procurement collection circulation policy towards the increasing frequency of book loaning in SMAN 3 Cimahi revealed the significant level of correlation.
