CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter contains two segments including conclusion and

recommendation. In conclusion, all findings and discussions in the previous chapter

are elicited as one to get the summary of the study. Furthermore, the recommendation

covers suggestions to English teacher and other researchers who are interested to

investigate more in the same issues.

5.1 Conclusions

Regarding the findings discussed in chapter IV, there are two main conclusions

relating to research questions engaged in this research encompassing the teachers'

perceptions towards the use of authentic materials and the teachers' difficulties in

using authentic materials in EFL classroom.

Relating to the first research question, here are two highlighted points. First, the

teachers' perceptions towards the use of authentic materials notice positive attitude in

terms of linguistic, including help to improve students' skill in language, they expose

learners to real language used, and enhance students' vocabulary mastery and non-

linguistic advantages, including help to improve students' motivation, as a window to

introduce students into culture, enhance teaching and learning progress (as cited in Al

Azri & Al-Rashdi, 2014).

Besides, the difficulties face by the teachers including time consuming in preparing

the material, technical problem occurs in the class when using aural authentic

materials, and internet connection error when accessing the materials.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the findings and conclusions above, several suggestions are recommended

for other studies in the present.

First, the implementation of using authentic materials in EFL classroom is beneficial

for the students. Hence, teacher should select suitable and or alter authentic materials

considering students' needs, interests, and language proficiency.

Second, the difficulties faced by the teacher can be manipulated by preparing a lot

before using authentic materials. Teacher also can ask students to search or bring the

material before the teachers delivering it into the class in order to get prior knowledge

about the issues will be discussed in the class.

And the last, the researcher can conduct similar research with different level of

participants concerning this issues. Also, another additional variable can be

formulated that may interfere teachers' perception and teachers' difficulties towards

the use of authentic materials for the future investigation.
