CHAPTER FIVE

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is a presentation of the research's conclusion and the

researcher's suggestion for any other ongoing researches that have connection

with the research in this paper or any other researches in the future.

5.1. **Conclusion**

This study aims to investigate two things from Mohammad Sanoesi's Siti

Rayati. The first one is to find how the Indo character is described in the novel.

The second one is to see what kind of Indo character Siti Rayati is. The first

question is answered by gathering the textual evidences regarding the descriptions

of Siti Rayati and dividing them into four categories telling how the character is

described.

The first category covers the textual evidence pointing at how Siti Rayati

is described in more superior nature than any other women. The second category

covers all the descriptions of Siti Rayati in the manner of being neutral or equal

with anyone. The third category is for the way Siti Rayati is described in the sense

of being in between. The fourth or the last category is for how Siti Rayati is

described to be influenced heavily by Dutch culture.

After getting the ways Siti Rayati is described from those categories, then

the researcher can see that Siti Rayati in the novel could be meant for giving

different point of view towards the stereotype of marginalized *Indo* people at that

time.

This could draw another meaning that Moh. Sanoesi's Siti Rayati was

published to invite its targeted readers, Sundanese people, for seeing people from

other race and social classes equally even if they came from the darkest past

because they might have bright future or good use for many people like the

character in the novel.

5.2. Suggestion

This research has been conducted in a way so that the researcher can

experience the process of the making. Based on the researcher's experience, it was

difficult to get data from the text, since the novel is too short. The shortness can

be seen by how the character's descriptions are done in such hasty ways. The one

that can be seen clearly is how Siti Rayati's development, from she is just a baby

until she studies in the collage, is described only in two short pages.

Therefore, the researcher suggests future researchers to find a longer and

clearer text to investigate. This will help the research to be richer in content. It is

because textual evidences are important in this kind of research.

The researcher also suggests the future researchers, especially in UPI, to

conduct more researches on Indonesian literary works. This can be done to enrich

the Indonesian literature researched in English. By so doing, the work can be read

by wider audience.
