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
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ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menjelaskan bentuk pengasuhan ibu narapidana kepada anaknya baik yang berada di dalam maupun yang ada di luar Lapas. Penelitian pengasuhan yang ada selama ini berfokus pada keluarga normal, kondisi yang tidak normal ini dianggap berbeda sehingga melahirkan perlakuan yang berbeda. Artikel ini menggunakan teori feminis post structuralis, diharapkan masalah lebih terbuka dengan memahami teori ini. Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah pendekatan studi kasus, dan pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui wawancara. Partisipan terdiri dua orang ibu narapidana yang berada di Lapas Perempuan Kelas IIA Bandung, yaitu ibu narapidana yang terpisah dengan anak dan yang membawa anak ke dalam Lapas. Ditemukan tiga tema besar dalam penelitian, konstruksi ibu ideal, negosiasi peran ibu ideal, dan pengelolaan citra ibu di depan anak. Penelitian ini bermaksud untuk mengisi kesenjangan pada penelitian terdahulu.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to explain the form of parenting of the inmate's mother to her children both inside and outside the prison. Parenting research that has been focusing on normal families, these abnormal conditions are considered different so that it gives birth to different treatments. This article uses post structuralist feminist theory, expected to be more open problem by understanding this theory. The method used in this study is a case study approach, and data collection is done through interviews. Participants consisted of two inmate mothers who were in the Women's Prison class 2A Bandung, namely the mother of the inmate who was separated from the child and who brought the child into the prison. Found three major themes in research, ideal mother construction, negotiation of ideal motherhood, and management of maternal image in front of the child. This study intends to fill the gap in previous research.
