ABSTRACT

For successful actualization educational management all school components, want support system form the principal, the teachers, and school administrations. The existence of Shool Administrations viewed have contributions in support successful educational management. This research focussing to discovery "How many contributions School Administrations in support educational management successful at SLTPN in area Bandung Timur?"

The method used in this research are the descriptive analitic with quantative approach and suplement study with interview and documentation study. The headmaster and School Administrations of SLTPN ini area Bandung Timur are the subject of this research. Data analysis with Product Moment Angka Kasar formulation.

Data analysis result identifying from all subvariables, are performance quality of School Administrations have contributions 84,6% with $(r_{xy} = 0.92)$ for education management at SLTPN in area Bandung Timur. With conclusion ellaboration for each subvariable are:

- Contributions of School Administrations as students manager in support education management successful are 94% with (r_{xy} = 0,97).
- Contributions of School Administrations as fungsional administration manager or the headmaster in support education management successful are 88% with (r_{xy} = 0,94).
- 3. Contributions of School Administrations as school budgetting manager in support education management successful are 81% with $(r_{xy} = 0.90)$.
- 4. Contributions of School Administrations as personalia manager in support education management successful are 82% with (r_{xy} = 0.91).
- 5. Contributions of School Administrations as school fasilitation manager in support education management successful are 88% with $(r_{xy} = 0.94)$.
- 6. Contributions of School Administrations as learning resources or school library manager in support education management successful are 88% with $(r_{xy} = 0.94)$.
- 7. Contributions of School Administrations as human relation manager both school with society in support education management successful are 81% with $(r_{xy} = 0.90)$.
