### ABSTRACT

This study aimed to investigate how an English teacher gave written feedback to the students' writing assignment through Google Classroom and types of written feedback the teacher used. This study used a case study design and the data were collected through classroom observations, text analysis, and interviews with the teacher and students. This study involved an English teacher and three students from one particular junior high school in Bandung as its research participants. This study used rubrics based on Ferris (2006) and Irwin (2018) regarding strategies in providing feedback and categories of teachers' written feedback to analyze the data. The findings of this study revealed that the teacher mostly used direct written feedback in valuing her students' writing assignment. Additionally, the findings also revealed that the feedback could lead the students to produce better writing as long as the feedback. The findings of this study also indicated some challenges faced by the teacher in providing effective feedback. It is recommended for teachers to pay attention to several aspects in order to provide feedback on the students' writing assignment better. In addition, it is also recommended that further research be conducted in order to investigate the similar issues in the future.
