CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analysis of nationalism across generation in "Nagabonar Jadi 2", we could see how nationalism between the two generations is actually different. The different construction of nationalism is maintained and reinforced in several manifestations of nationalism in various forms — there are three different manifestation of nationalism for the older generation found in the novel under study. The first form is manifestation of nationalism. 5.2 Suggestion

In regard with the study that has been elaborated in this paper, the writer has some suggestions for further studies related to literary works analysis.

- 1 For improvement in future studies pertinent to literary works analysis, like the one conducted in the present study, the selection of the research subject could be expanded with variation in terms of theme or genre.
- 2 Regarding nationalism, we, as parts of the net-like discursive relations of individuals, should be more critical in observing the operation of nationalism. We need to pay attention to the existing of unifying symbols and the history of nation struggling in the past. But we also keep

watching toward the changing world and its impact to our culture. Globalization doesn't mean the worst thing. We should be more open to the new things but we must be aware and careful.
