

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion of the research which is based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter. This chapter also presents the suggestion for further research based on the result of the research.

#### 5.1. Conclusion

The aim of the research is to uncover how *The Social Network* movie script constructs Mark Zuckerberg character. To perform the investigation, the research applies Rimmon-Kenan's (2002) theory of characterization namely direct characterization, indirect characterization, and characterization through analogy.

The result of the research shows that *The Social Network* movie script constructs Mark Zuckerberg character through several methods of characterization, which are in line with Rimmon-Kenan's theory of characterization mentioned above.

The story of *The Social Network* movie script describes directly what Mark Zuckerberg is like by using method of direct characterization such as describing Mark Zuckerberg character's physical appearance and traits. But, on the other hands, *The Social Network* movie script also describes what Mark Zuckerberg character is like by using indirect characterization method. *The Social Network* movie script uses the character's habit and other characters' opinion toward Mark Zuckerberg which is not described directly in the story to describe

Mark Zuckerberg's character traits. The movie script also uses the help of analogies to characterize Mark Zuckerberg character by using sign which is considered equal to Mark Zuckerberg's character traits which is intended to strengthen the characterization of Mark Zuckerberg character.

## 5.2. Suggestion

The present research applied Rimmon-Kenan's (2002) theory of characterization to reveal how *The Social Network* movie script constructs Mark Zuckerberg character. It is better for further research to apply not only Rimmon-Kenan's (2002) theory of characterization, but also Hawthorn's (2001) characterization theory. To provide better information about characterization in literary work, it is better to find out not only how a literary work construct a character, but also why the literary work construct a character to be that way.
