CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter is the final section of this paper. It provides conclusions and suggestions towards the study. DIKAN

5.1. Conclusions

The study was proposed to provide an answer regarding the thematic progression applied in the translated version of an informative text entitled The True Power of Water by Masaru Emoto. Based on the empirical data discussed in the previous chapter, the writer would like to highlight some conclusions regarding the focus study.

First, this study shows that there are three thematic progression patterns applied in the text. The highest frequent progression occurred in the text is linear progression which is found in 48 paragraphs with a frequency of 48%. The second frequent progression occurred in the text is derived progression which is found in 34 paragraphs with a frequency of 34%. The next progression pattern found in the text is constant progression which is found in 18 paragraphs with a frequency of 18%. Meanwhile, the writer did not find any split progression pattern in the paragraphs, thus, it has frequency of 0%.

Since the most frequent pattern is the linear progression, this study implies that the text is easily comprehended by the readers because the information is smoothly flowing that makes readers easier to catch the message. The linear progression pattern makes readers curious to find out the next information carried out by the text. Therefore, it is in line with the book function to deliver the contained information because the linear progression draws coherence in readers' perspective.

5.2. Suggestions

After conducting the research, the writer would like to give some suggestion regarding the study. First, since the linear progression pattern makes the readers easier to get the information in the book, this pattern is best applied for children's literature, educational textbook or another information sources dedicated to the society in general. Then, the writer also suggests to those who love writing activity to apply this thematic pattern in order to produce effective writing.

Second, cohesive device should be considered in order to produce a good writing. And last, the Emoto's *the True Power of Water* is classified into informative book that gives us some explanation about the miracle of water which can keep the energy. Not only the water, but also the food and many things around us can keep both negative and positive energy we produce. This energy comes from our utterance and behavior towards the environment. Therefore, this book functions is not only to report the research's findings but also teach us to be aware of every single thing we say and do toward the environment. So, this book is best suggested to everyone not only to enrich their knowledge but also to improve the awareness towards everything around us.
