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
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ABSTRAK

Pariwisata berkelanjutan adalah sebuah konsep yang ditujukan untuk mengatasi dampak negatif dari industri pariwisata terhadap lingkungan, masyarakat, dan budaya, dalam konteks ini, penelitian tentang identifikasi kompetensi *green jobs* di bidang pariwisata sangat penting untuk pengembangan industri pariwisata yang bertanggung jawab dan berkelanjutan. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menganalisis tren penelitian mengenai *green jobs* bidang pariwisata dengan menggunakan analisis bibliometrik yang disajikan dalam bentuk deskriptif, menganalisis hubungan antara *green competencies* dengan *green jobs*, dan untuk mengidentifikasi kompetensi yang dibutuhkan untuk *green jobs* di sektor pariwisata. Penelitian ini mengadopsi metode *Systematic Literature Review* (SLR) mengikuti pedoman PRISMA. Sebanyak 520 artikel dikumpulkan dari Google Scholar, Scopus, dan ScienceDirect, dan setelah menerapkan kriteria inklusi dan eksklusi, peneliti memilih 58 artikel yang relevan untuk dianalisis. Temuan studi menunjukkan bahwa tren penulisan artikel tentang kompetensi *green jobs* pada bidang pariwisata terjadi pada kurun waktu 1984 sampai 2023 dan dari hasil VOSviewer menunjukkan tema-tema yang berwarna redup seperti “*tourism*”, “*education*”, “*training*”, “*student*”, “*skill*”, “*teknology*”, “*job market*”, “*energy*”, dan “*industry*”. *Green jobs* juga berkontribusi pada peningkatan kesempatan kerja dan pengembangan ekonomi berkelanjutan dan hal ini menunjukkan bahwa masih ada potensi besar untuk penelitian lebih lanjut dalam topik ini. TVET juga memainkan peran penting dalam mempersiapkan tenaga kerja untuk transisi menuju pariwisata berkelanjutan dan dari hasil SLR ditemukan bahwa kompetensi untuk *green jobs* bidang pariwisata terdiri dari kompetensi pengetahuan, keterampilan dan sikap yang mendukung pariwisata berkelanjutan dan terdapat hubungan antara *green competencies* dan *green jobs* di sektor pariwisata terlihat dari fakta bahwa ada peningkatan permintaan untuk *green jobs* yang harus menguasai *green competencies*, implikasinya adalah penting untuk menerapkan pembelajaran berbasis *green competencies* di TVET dan ini semua perlu dukungan dari pemerintah, sektor industri pariwisata dan masyarakat
